Annual Report of the Institution (IQAC Activities)

IQAC of the college in the beginning of the session outlined various initiatives for the academic session 2020-2021 for overall improvement of teaching learning process and academics. Various activities that were executed are enumerated here under:

An Interdisciplinary Research Lab was established in the college by higher education department under NEP-2020 to ensure development of research skills among students and faculty. To promote and implement New Education Policy 2020, the college organized a webinar on the topic "Higher Education in J&K through NEP-2020" on 08-09-2021. The webinar aimed at educationists, students and the faculty to make NEP more effective and productive in near future.

In order to nurture a sense of responsibility towards environment, the college organized a virtual National Conference on "Climate Change: Greatest Threat to Humanity" from 21-09-2021 to 22-09-2021. To keep the students updated and well-informed in the field of science and technology, the college conducted a one-day webinar on "Emerging Technologies in Neuroscience and Related Career Opportunities" on 24-09-2021. The College organized an Alumni meet in which the students, faculty and the alumni meet, interacted and exchanged their views to foster a sense of affinity and connectedness.

In contemplation of overcoming the problem of technical glitch and promotion of digital adoption, the college organized a one-day training program on "Microsoft Office Tools" on 04-10-2021 for the Non-Teaching staff of the college. To make the non-teaching staff aware of the general financial rules, one-day workshop was conducted by the college on 21-10-2021.

A one day virtual webinar on "Characterization and Processing of Honey" on 7th December 2021 was organized by the department of Food Science and Technology in collaboration with IQAC. Dr. Vikas Nanda, Professor, Department of Food Process Engineering was the resource person and discussed about various techniques used in Honey processing. This webinar helped students to become entrepreneurs in the field of honey processing.

Feedback from parents was received to provide parents an opportunity to comment on the quality of their ward's learning experience. Parents suggested useful insights to improve the teaching-learning process. The other activities are uploaded on the college website.

At the end of the session it was noticed by the review committee that activities acted as a motivating guide for the students and helped them to set early goals and excel well.
