Terms and Conditions

- 1. The services must be provided for a period of one year, starting from the date of contract award. Any extension or modification of the contract period will be subject to mutual agreement.
- 2. The medical doctor should be available on call 24/7, while the ambulance service should be available within a maximum response time of 30 minutes for any emergency situations.
- 3. The medical doctor must be a licensed and registered medical practitioner with valid credentials. The ambulance service must be equipped with necessary medical equipment and staffed by qualified personnel.
- 4. The service provider must have a clear protocol for handling emergencies, including immediate communication with hostel authorities and rapid deployment of medical and ambulance services.
- 5. The service provider must maintain accurate records of all medical consultations, treatments administered, and ambulance deployments. Regular reports should be submitted to the college administration.
- 6. The service provider must have appropriate insurance coverage ambulance services, ensuring coverage for any liabilities or damages that may occur during service provision.
- 7. The service provider must adhere to all relevant health and safety regulations, including sanitation and hygiene standards, as well as compliance with college policies.
- 8. The quotation provided must clearly outline the rates for medical and ambulance services. Payments will be made on a visit/tour/monthly basis upon submission of an invoice and satisfactory performance of services.
- 9. The contract may be terminated by either party with a written notice of 30 days. In cases of breach of contract or unsatisfactory performance, the college reserves the right to terminate the contract immediately.
- 10. The service provider must maintain strict confidentiality of all medical information and personal data related to the students. No information should be disclosed to unauthorized parties without prior consent.
